### 2. Activity of the Civic Association

In 2019, the Civic Association developed activities aimed at supporting the activities and goals, in accordance with its statutes, primarily in the form of supporting the educational activities of medical staff of FDR UGH BB, but also in the form of improving and supporting the quality of health care, provided at FDR UGH BB.

#### Donations received

In 2019, the Civic Association received several financial donations from Medtronic Slovakia, s. r. o., Mölnlycke Health Care s. r. o., the COOP Jednota Foundation and the Civic Association Oncology of Banská Bystrica. These financial donations were used in accordance with the purpose for which they were granted, as shown in the overview below.

Company Medtronic Slovakia, s. r. o. made financial donations in the total amount of  $6,000 \in$ , to the Civic Association for the purpose of supporting the participation of medical staff of the FDR UGH BB at the 13th Colorectal Congress, St. Gallen.

Company Mölnlycke Health Care s. r. o. donated to the Civic Association a financial gift in the total amount of  $1,500 \in$ , to cover the costs of 1 person (a doctor of the FDR UGH BB) at the educational event - the EPUAP conference in Lyon, France.

Foundation COOP Jednota donated to the civil association a financial donation in the total amount of  $5,000 \in$ , for the purpose of supporting the continuation of the microbial transplantation project, which is implemented by II. Internal Clinic of SMU FDR UGH BB.

The Civic Association Oncology of Banská Bystrica made a financial donation to the Civic Association in the total amount of 500 €, for the purpose of sending funds to the account of the Civic Association without concluding a contract.

#### Other income

In 2018, the Civic Association successfully applied for registration in the "List of recipients of 2% of taxes" for 2019. The Civic Association received a total of 8,083.61 € from the remitted 2% of taxes.

#### Support of FDR UGH

Thanks to the funds provided to the Civic Association by donors, the Civic Association supported with a financial donation of  $2,190 \in$ , granted for the purchase of Orascoptic magnifying glasses, including individual focusing and fitting of TTL loupes.

In 2019, the Civic Association contributed to the improvement of the quality of health care provided at the FDR UGH by making a financial donation in the amount of 955.74 €, granted for the purchase of a KBL-02 cardiac chair with accessories (abduction armrest with joint including bracket, infusion stand including bracket, colour 8095).

The Civic Association released from its funds to the FDR UGH BB the amount of 341.40 € for the purpose of reimbursing the costs of an internship at IKEM for MUDr. M. S..

Funds were released by the Civic Association in the amount of 211.46 € for the purpose of reimbursing the costs of attending the EUROSPINE 2019 congress in Helsinki for MUDr. R. K..

From the financial resources of the Civic Association, an amount of 5,214.00 € for the purchase of Traction equipment ET-800 with accessories for the needs of the Department of Physiatry, Balneology and Medical Rehabilitation of the FDR UGH BB.

Thanks to the financial donation of the Civic Association in the amount of 5,010 €, FDR UGH BB could purchase a Lymphatic Drainage Machine for the needs of the Department of Physiatry, Balneology and Medical Rehabilitation of FDR UGH BB.

The Civic Association released funds for the purchase of Motomed VIVA 2 for the needs of the Department of Physiatry, Balneology and Medical Rehabilitation of the FDR UGH BB in the amount of 3,974.40 €.

The registration fee for 2019 for the European Society for Organ Transplantation ESOT Foundation was paid from the funds of the Civic Association in the amount of 500 €.

On the microbial transplantation project implemented by II. Internal Clinic of SZU FDR UGH BB for the examination of the microbiome in the intestine using the 16S-RNA methodology, CA paid M. K. the amount of  $150 \in$ , and A. R. the amount of  $90 \in$  on the basis of the Contribution Agreement.

The Civic Association has released from the funds an amount of 150 € for the purpose of supporting the education of medical staff of the FDR UGH BB on V. Regional Internal Medicine Seminar in Banská Bystrica.

#### Support for medical staff

### 3. Management of the Civic Association

At the beginning of the accounting period, on 1 January 2019, the Civic Association had financial resources in the total amount of 32,211.01 €. The Civic Association did not have any receivables or loans at the beginning or end of the 2019 financial year.

The balance of the Civic Association's funds as of 31 December 2019, at the end of the accounting period, was in a monetary institution in the total amount of 18,405.6 €. The balance of the funds of the Civic Association as of 31 December 2019, in the treasury, was in the total amount of 36.24 €.

The income of the Civic Association in 2019 consisted of income from legal entities, in the form of financial donations, and a substantial part of the income was also income from the 2% of taxes. The total income for 2019 was in the amount of  $21,083.61 \in$ .

Expenditure of the Civic Association in 2019 totalled 34,889.02 €. Of this amount, funds of 34,889.02 € for the activities, listed in point 2. Activities of the Civic Association, namely to support and improve the quality of health care provided in the FDR UGH, and to support the education of medical staff FDR UGH BB. Expenses of an amount of 280.19 € were used to cover the operating costs of the Civic Association, in particular rent, notary fees and administrative costs.
